Dr. Frederick Payne Watts earned his PhD while teaching at Howard University. He conducted independent research studying young African-American children and published "*A Comparative and clinical Study of Delinquent and*

Non-Delinquent Negro Boys". Dr. Watts developed psychological testing facilities and counseling services for Army personnel. He later served as clinical psychologist for Philadelphia's VA regional office. At Howard University he

established the University Counseling Service. He conducted notable studies through the counseling service, such as "*A Study of the College Environment, Developmental Counseling,*" and many more.
