Ph.D. Anthropology, 1971 University of California, Berkeley Dr. John U. Ogbu transferred from Princeton's Theological Seminary to study anthropology at UC Berkeley. His research interests included the impact of culture on education, as well as dissecting the differences between

cultures. He published Minority Education and Caste in 1978, which examines the differences between cultures and its impact on one's identity. The 1986 study of African-American high school students he conducted with Signithia Fordham found that the fear of being accused of "acting white" was keeping black students from reaching their academic potential. Their findings were summarized in Black American Students in an Affluent Suburb: A Study of Academic Disengagement.
