

## Reginald L. Jones, Ph.D.

1931 - 2005

Ph.D. Psychology, 1959 Ohio State University Dr. Reginald L. Jones is well known for his contributions to Black psychology. He was the author of 200 papers, articles and reviews. He also published 22 books, such as *Black Adult* Development and Aging, African American *Mental* 

Health, and Mainstreaming and the Minority Child. Prior to receiving his Ph.D., he was drafted into the US Army where he worked as a clinical psychologist. He also served on President Richard Nixon's Task Force on Mental Health and President-elect Bill Clinton's Council of Advisors to the Education Transition Team. Dr. Jones had an active academic career, working at Miami University, Fisk University, Indiana University, UCLA, Ohio State and UC Riverside.
