

## **Charles Henry Turner, Ph.D.**

Ph.D. Zoology, 1907 University of Chicago Charles Henry Taylor,
Professor and Chair of the
Department of Science and
Agriculture at Clark College
in Atlanta, Georgia was a
prolific author (over 70
publications) whose work

crossed multiple
disciplines. He is most wellknown for research which
established that honey bees
see in color and recognize
patterns. He was a life long
civil rights advocate who

made the argument that racism could be conquered through education and published articles on this in 1897 and 1902.
